



New rules 2011 for the professional category (Men Body)

Article 1 - General

This category is constituted by athletes whom obtained their professional card. To be recognized as professional athlete by the WABBA World, they must have won the title "Overall category" during the World Championship or WABBA Mr. & Ms. Universe organized by the WABBA, or win the title of World Champion on their categories at the WABBA.

Article 2

Athletes coming from outside federations must have imperatively won a world championship in an internationally recognized federation. They must then ask the international committee to receive their professional card. WABBA has the right to accept or refuse those requests.

Article 3

Each athlete will pay an annual fee of 100€ for their professional card. This amount can be paid either by bank to the WABBA world, or on the first day of the first competition of the year.

Article 4

An amateur athlete whom competes in the professional category for the first time, will have the possibility, after his first competition, to refuse to keep competing in this category and go back to his amateur category. For this reason, during his first professional competition, the athlete will receive no money, whatever result he will get.

Article 5

During his second competition in the professional category, the athlete commits himself to never compete in an amateur category either in the WABBA federation, or elsewhere.

If he does not respect his commitment, he will be penalized by the WABBA World, ...
